





words "Family is Better than Gold" captioned the drawing. Sawyer explained to us that he drew his brother or sister because he or she would definitely be with us someday. We were so proud of him in that moment, for having such a big heart and expressing it so creatively. If chosen, we would never let your little one forget the way their unique and long-awaited presence contributes to our family dynamic in a way no one else ever could. And, we would speak at length on how grateful we are to you for having chosen us to be his or her family. We would discuss your choice with admiration and gratitude, and we would take every opportunity to honor the unconventional nature of our family and all the people and stories that converged to bring us together. With your blessing, we would continuously remind your child of how both you and we always believed he or she was meant to make their mark on the world, and a difference in all our lives.




## Everyday Magic & Adventure

Every adopted person we know maintains a different level of openness and contact with their birth family, which has shown us firsthand that adoption doesn't look any one particular way. There are as many variations of circumstance as there are placements. What we've learned about adoption through our relationships with these family members is that releasing all expectation and being open, honest, and flexible while remembering to stay united in honoring the best interests of the adoptee seems to be key.



We consider ourselves lucky that OUR FAMILY LOVES THE GREAT OUTDOORS AS MUCH AS WE DO! #### Traditions






#### Bastian + Shadow + Atticus




