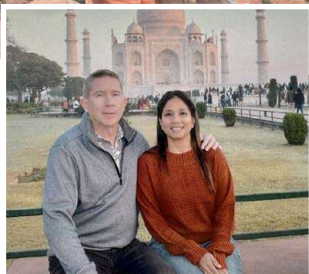


OUR FAVORITE ADVENTURES
